What is your biggest accomplishment this year?



The Catcher in the Rye

The Catcher in the Rye certainly wouldn't be everyone's cup of WHISKEY; however, I find it an exciting and compelling read, with a gallon of brutal reality poured in along with some humor, contrasting with moments of depression.

Despite being written in 1951, I think many teenagers would be able to relate to the various themes present in the book. It is a modern classic of the coming of age genre. I find the main character, 17-year-old Holden Caulfield, intriguing and as I read the book, it was fascinating to relate with him on many levels.

The whole story is almost a three-day flashback with occasional references to the present. One thing that sets The Catcher in the Rye apart from other similar novels, I think, is the frequent use of profanity - be warned! The heavy use of colloquialism is effective in making the reader relate to the charac-



ters better and make the characters seem realistic, but on the other hand, if you're under fourteen, I would certainly not recommend the novel to you! It isn't only the language used that makes The Catcher in the Rye unsuitable for younger readers, but also the themes discussed, centered around the idea of morality.

Rozhodla jsem se udělat rozhovor s trenérem A týmu SK Slavia Praha, Jaroslavem Šilhavým, najít nějaké spojitosti se střední školou. Tento rozhovor vznikl týden předtím, než se stala Slavia mistrem. Sami si můžete přečíst, co zajímavého jsem se dozvěděla.

Jaké vlastnosti by podle Vás měl mít úspěšný hráč, který vyniká nad ostatními?

Já bych vypíchl především, že musí

mít fotbal rád od malička. Když si vzpomenu na svá mladá léta, my jsme tu "mičudu" milovali a radovali jsme se. Když si promítnu sebe, fotbal jsem miloval. Samozřejmě první byl můj pocit, že se mi to líbí a že to dělám dobře, což byly branky, které jsem ještě za mlada dával. (smích) Následovala pochvala, která mě také posouvala výš a motivovala mě.

Bral jste jinak pochvalu od trenéra než od táty? Bylo to jiné?

Když jsem byl malý, tak to byla jedna osoba. Teď se to, ale všechno mění. Tato doba je dynamičtější, ale musím říct, že pořád je nejdůležitější mít fotbal rád a mít touhu něco dokázat.

Představme si, že je talentovaný 16letý hráč, který hraje v top klubu v České republice. Je možné, aby studoval gymnázium a vše stíhal v pohodě?

Já si myslím, že to lze. Dokonce mám kolem sebe kamarády, kteří vystudovali vysokou školu, ale v současné době to už tak lehké. To by hráč podepisující profesionální smlouvu musel myslet na to, že bude studovat a do kontraktu zahrnout to, že ho trenér uvolní atd. Podle mého názoru v profesionálním fotbale to není jednoduché, aby trenér uvolňoval hráče, aby šel do školy. Ale znám kluky kolem sebe, kteří to zvládají a klobouk dolů před nimi. Většinou jsou potom fotbalisté leniví, což je škoda.

Momentálně bojujete o titul, na hráče je určitě velký tlak. Myslím, že se dá porovnávat s tlakem ve škole – samozřejmě při těch největších tes-

tech – jak s hráči pracujete? Můžete doporučit nějaká cvičení?

Ano, velký tlak tady je a každý ho snáší jinak. Existuje spousta postupů od teambuildingu (např. my jsme byli na paintballu, naposledy jsme byli všichni na



večeři) po mentální kouče v kabině. Toto je hodně důležité. Každý potřebuje osobní přístup. Trenér hráče pozná a ví, kteří jsou více a méně nervóznější. Ale se zkouškou ve škole se to podle mě srovnat nedá, protože od tebe neočekává úspěch např. 15 000 fanoušků. Z toho můžeš vyvodit, že tlak na hráče vytváří média, hráč sám a mnoho dalších faktorů.

Máte Vy osobně nějaký způsob, jak se s tlakem vypořádat, protože na Vás je ten tlak také obrovský?

To je pravda, hráči vylezou na hřiště, zapomenou a vyběhají se z toho. Trenér to má složitější. Pomáhá mi, když si jdu zaběhat, zpotím se a přijdu na jiné myšlenky. Mám tři vnoučata, když přijdou, tak se to tady všechno rozsvítí. Ale když jsem přišel včera po zápase domů (remíza s Duklou Praha), tak to byla tma. Člověk si to pořád přetáčí v hlavě, ale dnes už je to v pohodě.

Jaký máte důvod k učení se angličtiny?

Já jsem začínal už mockrát. Ale protože jsem v České republice odmala, nic mě nedonutilo se angličtinu naučit pořádně. Na rozdíl od některým mých kolegů, kteří šli do zahraničí. Ti se museli učit, aby se dorozuměli. Žili v cizojazyčném prostředí a angličtinu se naučili. Naopak já jsem nikdy nikde nebyl. Ale v koutku duše si říkám, že by ještě nějaké angažmá ze zahraničí mohlo přijít, to je můj největší důvod.

Ve Slavii jsou hráči, kteří mají ambice hrát v zahraničí, máte nějaký program, který by jim mohl pomoci ve zdokonalení se v angličtině?

Český hráč má ambice se dostat do zahraničí, takže když nestíhá vysokou školu, tak minimálně se učit jazyk by mělo být automatické. Oficiálně klub pro hráče v tomto ohledu nic nedělá. Ale naopak ti hráči, kteří přijedou sem ze zahraničí, mají české lektory, kteří je učí česky. Ale je to menší procento, protože čeština je těžká. Většinou začnou a skončí. Ale když tady je hráč déle, například Deli (je to Afričan), umí už česky, ne úplně dokonale, ale domluví se.

A jejich agenti, nemají něco ohledně jazyků v programu? Protože agent má za úkol hráče podporovat a připravovat na zahraniční angažmá.

Agenti by měli hráči poskytovat veškerý servis, aby se tady začlenil. Když toto nefunguje, může to suplovat klub. Nebo například Flo, velice sympatický a inteligentní kluk, se s manželkou sami doučují. To je pozitivní.

Jak jsou na tom hráči z ciziny s angličtinou?

Většina, která tady je, tak umí anglicky. Z Afriky máme dva hráče, kteří umí anglicky, francouzsky i jejich jazykem. Michell umí i německy. A v neposlední řadě fotbalový jazyk je mezinárodní.
